

This is a proactive change, due to port congestion which may impact future cruise operations. Free shuttle service from Venice's Marco Polo will be provided or from the Royal Caribbean pre-hotel with a purchased package.

- * If arriving on July 3, please plan to arrival ay Venice's Marco Polo airport no later than 11:00 a.m. for customs and shuttle to Ravenna, Italy.
- * For return flights on July 10, we recommend a departure after 11:30 a.m. or choose a post hotel and spend time in Venice and surrounding areas.

Venice, Italy

The capital of northern Italy's Veneto region, the city is built on more than 100 small islands in a lagoon in the Adriatic Sea.

It has no roads, just canals, including the Grand Canal thorough fare lined with Renaissance, Gothic palaces.

The central square, Piazza San Marco, contains St. Mark's Basilica, which is tiled with Byzantine mosaics, and the Campanile bell tower offering views of the city's and its iconic red roofs



Kotor, Montenegro

Kotor is a fortified town on Montenegro's Adriatic coast, in a bay near the limestone cliffs of Mt. Lovćen.

Characterized by winding streets and squares, its medieval old town has several Romanesque churches, including Kotor Cathedral. It's also home to the Maritime Museum, which explores local seafaring history.

Corfu, Greece

Corfu, an island known as the cradle of culture ans science, is also defined by rugged mountains and a resort-studded shoreline.

Its cultural heritage reflects years spent under Venetian, French and British rule. Corfu Town, flanked by 2 imposing Venetian fortresses, features winding medieval lanes, a French-style arcade and the grand Palace of St. Michael and St. George.

Athens, Greece

Athens, the capital of Greece. It was also at the heart of Ancient Greece's powerful civilization and empire.

The city is still dominated by 5th-century BC landmarks, including the Acropolis, a hilltop citadel topped with ancient buildings and the colonnaded Parthenon temple.

The Acropolis Museum, along with the National Archaeological Museum, preserves sculptures, vases, jewelry and more from Ancient Greece.

Mykonos, Greece

Located in the Cycladic region of the beautiful Aegean Sea, Mykonos offers amazing beaches, beautiful nature, picturesque villages, delicious Greek food and a chic lifestyle.

It is also known for its summer party atmosphere. Beaches such as Paradise and Super Paradise have bars that blare thumping music.



Massive dance clubs attract world-renowned DJs and typically stay open well past dawn. Iconic landmarks include a row of 16th-century windmills, which sit on a hill above Mykonos.





Argostoli is the capital town of the picturesque island of Kefalonia, one of Greece's beautiful lonian islands.

The town has been reformed keep with the neoclassical style of its former architecture. Argostoli nestles around a sheltered bay, known as 'Koutavos Lagoon.




